Feather louse collected from Terek Sandpiper (Xenus cinereus)

On August 20, 2007 a Terek Sandpiper (*Xenus cinereus*) with a Polish ring was captured at the ringing station of Fertőújlak by *Dénes Laczik*. As a courtesy *Dr Tibor Hadarics* collected feather lice from the bird and sent me for identification. One male, 5 females and a larva of the feather louse *Carduiceps fulvofasciatus* (Grube, 1851) were collected from the bird. Since this for Hungary quite scarce bird species has not been investigated before for ectoparasites the feather louse collected from this individual was a new species to Hungary.
